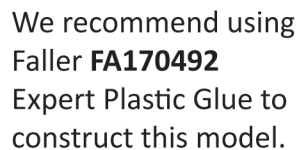


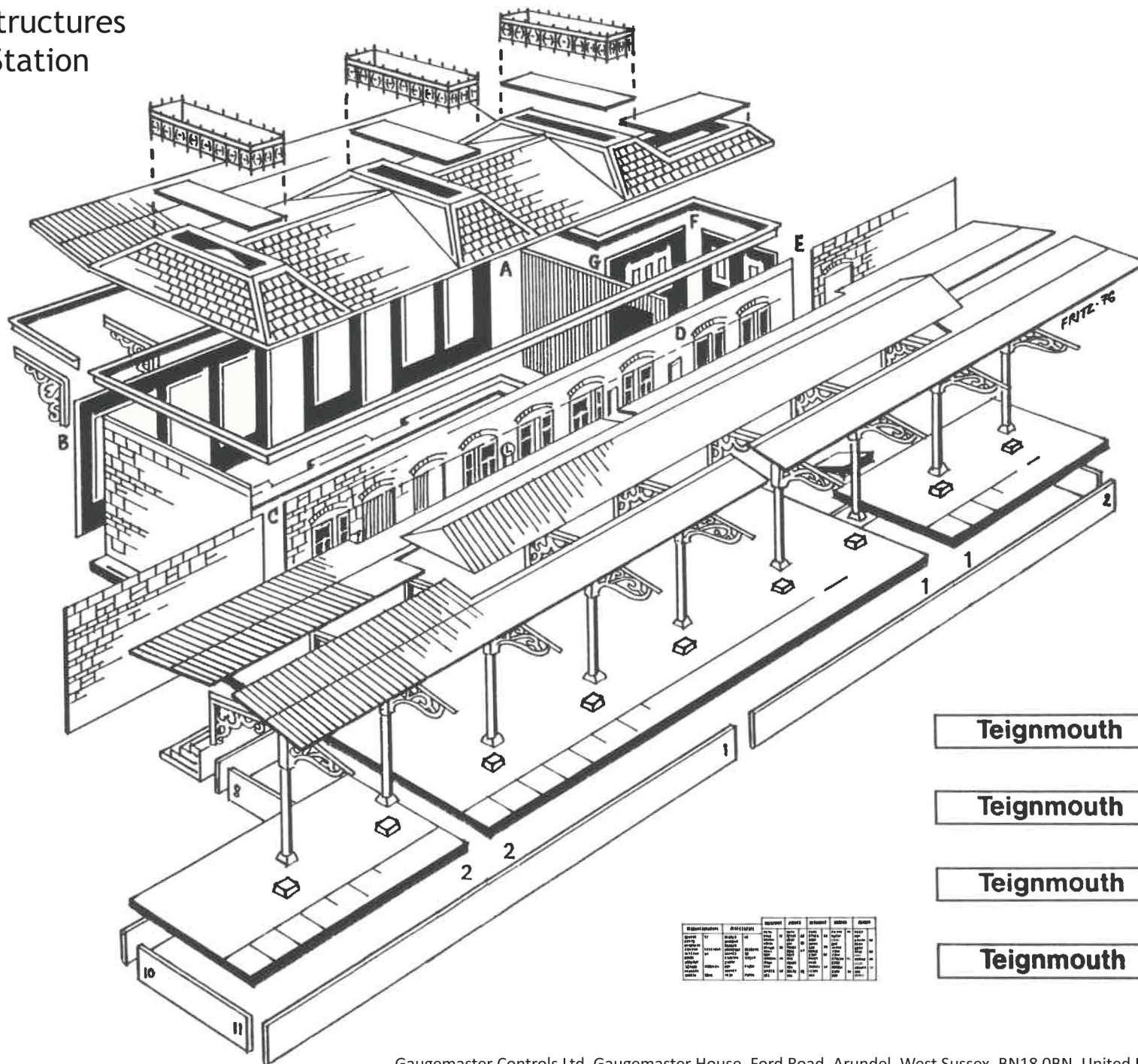


It's always best to have a 'dry run' with parts to ensure a good fit before they are glued.
