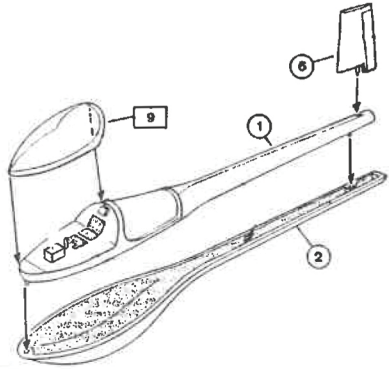




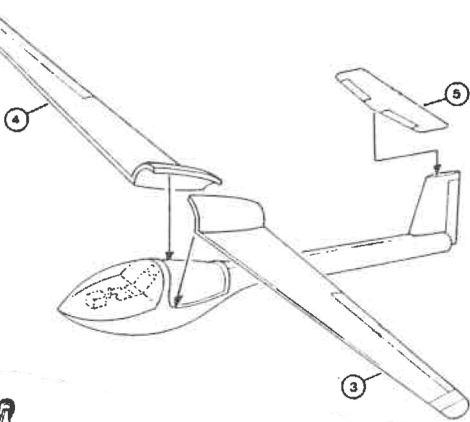

Before beginning to assemble this kit, familiarise yourself with the parts and instructions. It's always best to have a 'dry run' with parts to ensure a good fit before they are glued.

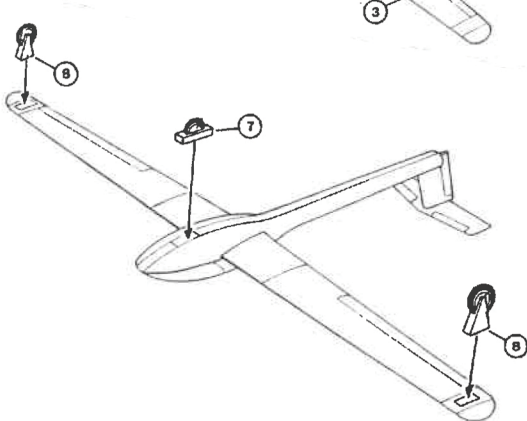

- Always keep this kit out of reach of children, unless they are being supervised by an adult.

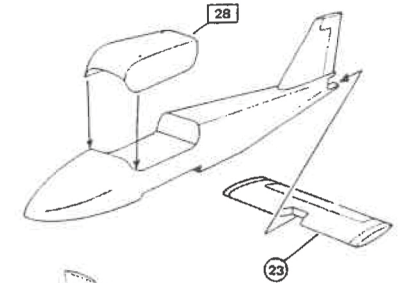

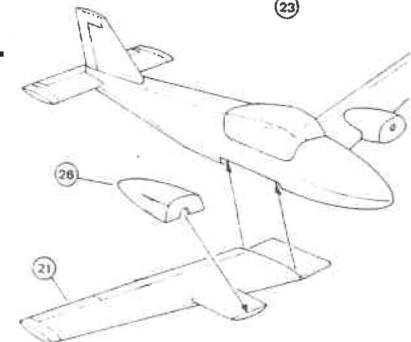

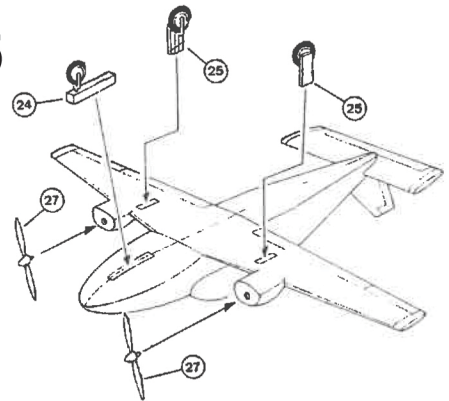
